

Brisons Veor – artists' residential studio at Cape Cornwall

UK Residency costs 2023 - 2024 at Brisons Veor, Cape Cornwall.

Low Season

15 September 2024 – 14 June 2024: **£350** per week

An extra service charge is payable if bedding is required.

High Season

15 June - 14 September 2024: £450 per week for the resident artist,

There is an extra charge of £150 per week for each additional person.

International Residency Costs 2023 - 2024 at Brisons Veor, Cape Cornwall.

Low Season

10 September 2023 – end December 2023: **£400**

14 September 2024 – end December 2024: **£400**

There is an extra charge of £150 per week for each additional person.

High Season

15 June - 14 September 2024: £500 per week for the resident artist,

There is an extra charge of £150 per week for each additional person.

Booking procedure:

- An invoice for £100 will be sent to you for a non-refundable deposit, which will secure your booking.
- An invoice for the balance will be sent 4-6 weeks before the start date of the residency.
 Additional visitors are asked to pay £150 per week by BACS, or cheque payable to Brisons
 Veor, and sent to the Trust Administrator. If you think you will have extra guests please let
 the TA know so that you can be invoiced accordingly.
- Once payment has been received, advance information will be sent to you, usually about a week before your residency.

Terms and Conditions:

Cancellations

When you make a booking and have paid the deposit, a legally-binding contract exists between you and the Trust that cannot be cancelled unless there are exceptional circumstances.

If you cancel *after* paying the balance, we shall only be able to refund the payment *if an alternative, Trustee-approved artist has been found to take up the residency*. This means you may still remain liable to pay in full, even if you are unable to take up your residency at Brisons Veor. You may wish to consider taking out cancellation insurance from a reputable supplier.

Liability:

Artists are expected to have their own Public Liability Insurance. (This is a service that is offered to members of A-N, the artists network; it is included with their membership fee.)

We are not insured for your personal belongings or for the use of hazardous materials or equipment. As far as the law allows, the Trustees of the Brisons Veor Charitable Trust take no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to the resident artist or beneficiary as a consequence of the residency contract.
